During the 2016 Form 990 preparation, it was discovered that the public support test on the 2015 Form 990, encompassing the five years 2011-2015, 3 donors had their donations classified as private support when these donors were actually publically supported organizations whose donations should have been reflected in public support. The 2016 Form 990 includes the restatement of all effected amounts. The effect of the correction was to increase the cumulative public support percentage. The change was not related to a tipping point issue, as the organization's public support has been above 50% throughout its history.
